Tinicum Township – The Tinicum Township Branch lobby will be closed to the public; however, our drive-thru will remain open during our normal business hours. Branch personnel will be available to speak with you over the phone during normal business hours and can be reached at 610-521-1080. If you have more complex banking needs, we ask you to make an appointment.

Ridley Township — Until further notice, the Ridley Township Branch, will be closed on Saturdays. The Tinicum Township Branch, drive -thru only, will remain open on Saturdays from 9AM to 12PM. Monday through Friday, the Ridley Township Branch lobby will remain closed to the public; however, we will continue to offer curbside banking at the front of the branch during normal business hours. Upon your arrival, our branch personnel will come to your vehicle or will meet you outside the front door of the branch. Branch personnel will be available to speak with you over the phone during normal business hours and can be reached at 610-532-2034. If you have more complex banking needs, we ask you to make an appointment.

Rest assured that you will have complete access to your funds and bank services. We encourage you to utilize ATMs, your Debit/ATM cards and our on-line/mobile banking to access your accounts.
